

Kansetsu-waza (armlocks) are not permitted in Novice Divisions and are not permitted in any open
rank matches when a Novice is competing against an Elite rank.
Blue JUDOGIS NOT REQUIRED, and Blue may only be worn when called as Blue. Blue and white belts
will be available for use. We will be utilizing a single competition area. Competition area will be 8m x
8m with 5m safety; CARE system will be used along with electronic scoreboard.
- **<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>**: Competitors ages 30 and older with USJF, USJI, or USJA current affiliation are eligible to compete. Copy of current membership card must be submitted with registration and card must be presented at weigh-in. **NO EXCEPTIONS - Competitors may apply for membership on site.**
- FEES:\$35.00 for 1st Division; \$10.00 for 2nd Division if postmarked by JULY 27, 2019\$45.00 for 1st Division; \$10.00 for 2nd Division if postmarked after JULY 27, 2019\$50.00 for ALL WALK-UP REGISTRATIONS ON AUGUST 4TH 2nd Division will be \$10.00NO REFUNDS.
